The vast majority of brain development takes place in the earliest years of a child’s life. The first five years lay the foundation for all future social, emotional, and cognitive development. NR4K believes that all families who are interested in quality early learning experiences for their four-year-old children should have equal access to a high quality program by partnering existing local programs with state funding.

While parents and families are the child’s first and foremost teacher, the community shares a responsibility and a vested interest in all children’s well-being and development. As New Richmond grows, we want to be able to offer families positive early educational opportunities. By investing in 4-year-old kindergarten we are also investing in the future of our community.

## Who Can Participate?

Any child who will be four years old by September 1, 2022 will be eligible to participate. ## How Much Will It Cost?

Wisconsin's school funding system provides funding for 4-Year-Old Kindergarten programs based on the number of students enrolled. **There will be no charge to parents for district sponsored NR4K programming, no matter where the site is located.** Sites that offer extended day childcare will still charge for childcare services. Check your site's handbook for the specific fee schedule.

## What Can I Expect?

As an early education program, NR4K will focus on reading and language arts, but will also include math, social studies, science, health, physical education, creative art and music. Young children learn by doing, exploring, and experimenting in an integrated, nurturing environment. A typical day would include some teacher-directed instruction, many "hands-on" activities, and opportunities for child-initiated play.

## Where Will My Child Go to NR4K?

The purpose of a community 4-Year-Old Kindergarten program is to collaborate with the existing expertise, experience and facilities of private providers in the community. The following is a list of NR4K community sites that will be available for the 2022-2023 school year. Parents can choose a site that best fits the needs of their 4-year-old.

New Richmond Head Start/NR4K is a high quality, federally funded, full-day preschool program. Age appropriate activities are offered to build school readiness skills. Areas of learning are; language and literacy, cognitive and general knowledge, physical and social/emotional development. The classroom of 20 children is staffed with a WI DPI licensed teacher and 2 teacher assistants with Child Development Associate certification. Screeners and on-going assessment help parents and teachers recognize the strengths and needs of each individual child. Family engagement is critical for children's success and parents are strongly encouraged to participate in the program. Parent meetings, home visits and conferences are offered to ensure that parents receive the best possible services and gain child development knowledge. Health & dental screening, are also provided through Head Start. Head Start provides a nutritious home cooked breakfast and lunch, as well as a nutritious snack at the end of the day.
